#### **QR** code

### Tutorial

Using QR codes is very simple and easy. With this tool, you will surely inspire your pupils to engage in the lesson.

- 1. Type "QR Code" in the search box of your web browser. Choose one of the available QR code creation websites, click "+Create".
- 2. Select the QR Code campaign type, upload your file (picture, video, document and ect.), or paste the file URL.
- 3. Customise your QR Code appearance. Design your QR Code as per your brand aesthetics for better visibility. Change the QR Code colour or shape, and add a logo, CTA, and frame. Once done, click "Next".
- 4. Your QR Code is ready for distribution. Scan and test your QR Code. Download it in any of the formats available and share it with your student.

## Example

# Geography. Europe's longest rivers. (Secondary Level - Ages 14)



- Choose a map of Europe to use as a basic visual aid.
- On this map, insert a QR code next to each of Europe's longest rivers with additional visual material (the most impressive photo of the river, a video, information about the river that the student needs to learn, etc.).
- For creating each QR code, follow the instructions already described in the section above. The QR codes can be different colours, for example a yellow QR code for a photo, a red QR code for a video, and a green QR code for textual information.
- Once the students have this map with the QR codes, they can explore it, scan the QR codes with their phone or tablet, and access the information you have provided.
